# **Bioceltix: buy (new)**

## For Happier Paws and Hooves

Bioceltix is a biotechnology company developing mesenchymal stem cell-based therapies in veterinary medicine. The company submitted a dossier to the European Medicines Agency concerning Project BCX-CM-J for the treatment of osteoarthritis in dogs on May 17, 2024. Pivotal study results in Projects BCX-CM-AD (atopic dermatitis in dogs) and BCX-EM (arthritis in horses) are expected in 2H24.

In June, Bioceltix successfully completed a secondary public offering of its shares, raising PLN 43m net. The funds will be used to upgrade the manufacturing capacity for mesenchymal stem cells.

We initiate coverage of Bioceltix with a Buy recommendation and 12M Target Price of PLN 106/share, implying 46% upside potential.

#### A Biotech Company Developing MSC-Based Therapies in Animal Health

Bioceltix develops innovative therapies in veterinary indications. It has developed three projects based on allogenic adipose-derived (i.e., from fat) Mesenchymal Stromal Cell (MSCs): (1) BCX-CM-J – a potential first- or best-inclass therapy based on canine (from dog) MSCs for the treatment of osteoarthritis in dogs, (2) BCX-CM-AD – canine MSCs to treat atopic dermatitis in dogs, and (3) BCX-EM – equine (from horse) MSCs to treat arthritis in horses. The company has also been working on MSCs as a therapy for cats and a secretome project – both in early discovery stage.

The goal of Bioceltix is to sign a licensing deal with one of the world's leading animal health companies. Negotiations with selected players are ongoing.

#### Clinical Proof-Of-Concept in Two Indications, Third on the Way

In the BCX-CM-J project, Bioceltix has completed a pivotal study showing a clear clinical benefit in both pain and lameness in dogs with osteoarthritis. The BCX-CM-AD project has successfully completed a pilot study, and results of a pivotal one will likely be published in 4Q24. The pivotal study of BCX-EM was completed in 2Q and the results are expected in 3Q24.

#### Animal Health Market

Development of a new veterinary medicine takes much less time and cost compared to human drugs, and there is less generics competition. There are strong unmet medical needs in both osteoarthritis (OA) and atopic dermatitis (AD) in companion animals in our view. The standard of care in OA is focused primarily on pain management, with Zoetis's Librela, indicated for pain in OA in dogs, likely to become a billion-dollar molecule in the coming years. In AD, the treatment is mostly immunosuppressive and associated with adverse effects or focused on reducing itchiness.

### **Investing SPO Proceeds in MSC Capacity Upgrades**

In order to finance the construction of a EUR 9m manufacturing facility, and fund ongoing operations, in June 2024, Bioceltix issued 795k M-series shares (16% of current shares outstanding) at PLN 58 per share. At the same time, Infini ASI sold its entire 6% stake in the company, worth PLN 14m, in the SPO.

#### rNPV-Based Target Price at PLN 106/share

Our rNPV model points to a target price of PLN 106/share, incl. BCX-CM-J valued at PLN 75/share, BCX-CM-AD at PLN 25/share and BCX-CM-EM at PLN 3/share. The main risks to our valuation include failures and delays in R&D projects, and competition risk, specifically competition from Vetbiobank, which submitted a dossier to the EMA concerning its canine neonatal stem cells for the treatment of osteoarthritis in dogs in May 2024.
